Annually an awardee is chosen at an event deemed suitable by the Full Committee by a judging panel consisting of three suitably qualified ACMC committee members.

Rita also has a wide range of experience, locally and in Queensland, and has a vocal ability that covers a diverse range from the rock of Tina Turner to the mellow numbers of Linda Rhondstadt, with Shania Twain and Leanne Rimes in there somewhere for good measure!

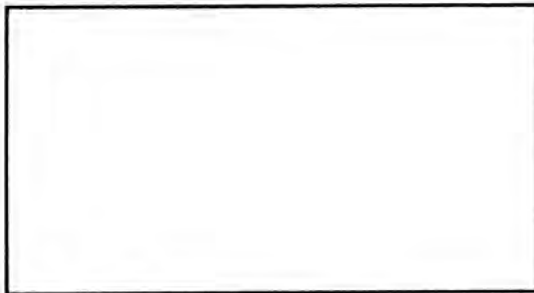
