Contributions to the fund, which may be made to the club treasurer at any time will be acknowledged in the club newsletter.

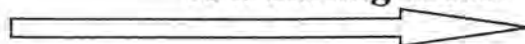

Peter Coad and the Coad Sisters, Lynette and Virginia, have been involved in the entertainment industry for many years, performing throughout Australia, from the Sydney Opera House to the Gympie Muster, From the Royal Adelaide Show to the Brisbane Expo in 1988. They've appeared at festivals and clubs all over the country, appearing with such legendary greats as Tom T Hall.

Peter is a bush poet, balladeer and song-writer specialising in Australiana, garnered along the 80,000 odd kilometres he travels, performing

at over 100 venues, every year. Originally from Hawker in the Flinders ranges, he now lives at Bunadood in the NSW Southern Highlands. He has been a finalist at the Tamworth Song-writers Awards and in 1998 his "Bush Verse" CD was a finalist in the best album category at the Tamworth Golden Gumleaf Awards.

In 1990 Peter was joined by his sisters Lynette and Virginia who are both accomplished and versatile musicians, playing guitar, fiddle, mandolin, harmonica, keyboard and drums (not all at the same time). As well as their instrumental skills the sisters are renowned for their distinctive harmonies and clear strong vocals which accounts for their popularity and success on tour.

With a number of albums to their credit they are all accomplished musicians who present an exciting show that's sure to be a lot of fun.

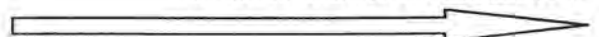

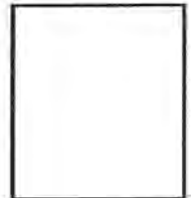
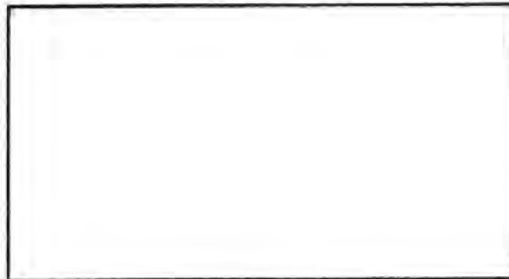
