LEN WAKEFIELD MEMORIAL FUND

Subject to certain conditions, the purpose of the fund is to assist younger talent with proven ability: a) in entering talent quests throughout Sth Aust, Mildura and Tamworth, b) by payment or part payment of professional tuition, and c) towards the cost of a musical instrument.

The fund is administered by the APMC committee with expenditure limited to the interest from capital invested, with all payments made to the appropriate body and NOT to the awardee. Annually an awardee is chosen at an event deemed suitable by the Full Committee by a judging panel consisting of three suitably qualified APMC committee members.

Contributions to the fund, which may be made to the club treasurer at any time will be acknowledged in the club newsletter.

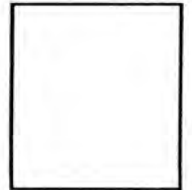
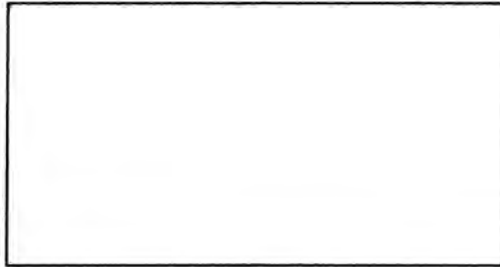
