In the meantime, the children (Claire, Amy and Kane) have been involved in the Junior Country Crossover for young performers with Anthony providing JCC with workshops on 'Using PA Systems' and 'Playing Acoustic Guitar'. Anthony and Tracy have expanded their family by one with Brooke Melody born 14 August 2006.

Always keen to expand his musical horizons, in 2005 Anthony joined (and continues to play with) the reformed *Jessie Che Band* as the Lead Acoustic Guitar and Mandolin player. As a full-time musician Anthony also freelances with many other South Australian Country Music artists and can be booked accordingly.

The Sherrahs have also worked with some of Australia's top acts. Artists include Karen O'Shea, Michael King, Owen Blundell, Brian Letton, Craig Giles and Kasey Chambers to name a few. The band also gained much notoriety on the nationwide circuit when The Sherrahs released '*Keep in the light*' on ABC country and followed up with '*Reason and Rhyme*' in 2002, at the Red Brick

Marie was also a volunteer office worker at Coast FM Community Radio station keeping the program presenters informed about coming events and the latest CDs being released.

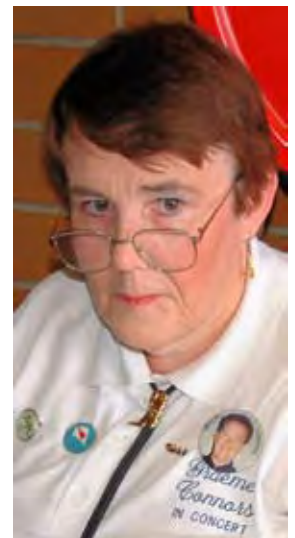
She must have been number one fan of Graeme Connors because she took every opportunity to attend his concerts. It was while on the way to a Graeme Connors show that
