He started to play in cabaret bands as a singer/guitarist all over Adelaide and surrounding country areas. During those years he spent many hours playing in clubs and hotels.

In more recent times he has worked as a soloist and has appeared mainly within the country music scene.

Phil has been a regular performer at the Riverland, Murraylands and Northern Country Music Festivals for the some years. He has won two awards at the Port Pirie.

A highlight of Phil's music is his guitar playing.

He still plays his Fender Stratocaster which he bought brand new in 1974.

October Show:- special guest Melody Feder

Melody Feder is one of South Australia's most promising up and coming Country music artists, with a swagger on awards and accolades to her name, she is one to watch. Born in 1988 in Adelaide, Melody has grown up with Country music and names artists such as Dolly Parton, Linda Rondstat and the Dead Ringer band as her early influences.

Melody began entering Talent Quests at the age of 12 and from an early age her talent was recognized. She received many awards over the years but is especially proud of her achievements in 2009/2010 which include:- grand finalist in 2009 SA Champion of Champions, VIC Champion of Champions Finalist, Telstra road to Tamworth finalist, 1st & 2nd place in Songwriters and Runner up for the Frank Harding memorial trophy at SA Country music festival.

This year Melody was approached by Bundaberg Rum to appear as a guest artist at the 2010 Optus Muster in Gympie.

Melody sings with a duo called "Pretty Radio" who recently made the top 23 groups in the Channel 7 series of "The X-Factor". Melody has said of the experience "It was so amazing to see a country duo featured amongst the regular pop artists, we wanted to send the message that Country music is just as cool as any other genre!" Pretty Radio, now consisting of Melody Feder and Hollie May O'Neill,

perform regularly around SA and would love to see you at one of their gigs.

If you have seen Melody perform you will know she impresses with her vocals and stage presence but she would like to think that her original songs are her main focus, "when I picked up a guitar last year and my dad began teaching me to play, It was like a whole new world opened up, writing songs and performing them to others is such a great feeling". This year, Melody has been concentrating on recording her own original EP with local producer Anthony Stewart and is excited to share her songs with the world. She has qualified for this year's Champion of Champions so keep your eyes out for the launch of her EP and make sure you come along and support young Country music!

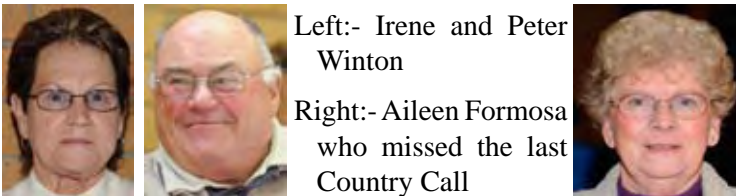

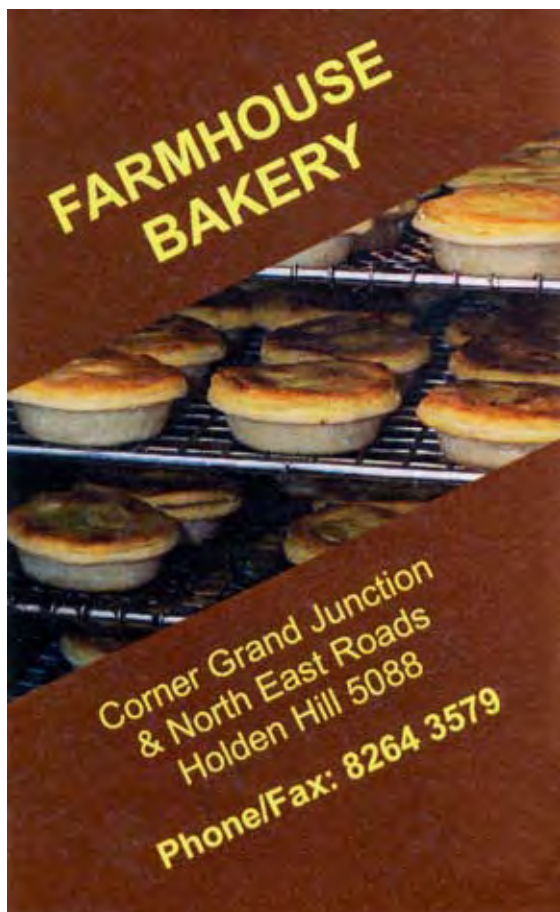
