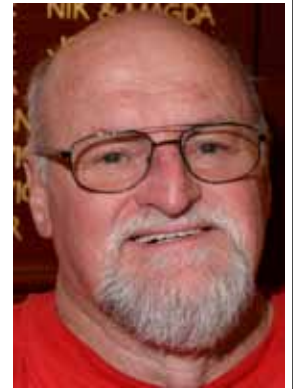
Many thanks to our committee members and volunteers and specially to the members for their support, and thanks to the Slovenian members behind the bar, well there's no more to say so cheerio for now.
