The band represented South Australia, for the City of Marion in Tokyo in 1995 and 1997, performing their own original music and all Australian music.

The band have been fortunate to have performed with many wonderful top artists, and attended the Tamworth Country Music Festival for 16 years appearing on many popular shows including the South Australia showcase at the Hands of Fame Park. The band has appeared on two occasions for the Alice Springs Country Music festival and taking country music on the Ghan to the Alice.

The band more recently appeared at the W A Country Music Awards, Hopetoun Country Music Festival and Queanbeyan Awards.

The band also is part of the Barmera Country Music Festival, having performed at Barmera for the last 26

years.

They have achieved many accolades, awards & honours and donate many hours to charity, community events and the country music industry.

Judith is the band manager, and was awarded the ACMC industry award in 2000, then more recently very proud to be appointed on 10th August this year, as The Patron for the Southern Country Music Club.

Musically the band has a wide repertoire of music, can play the beautiful old standards of country, Patsy Cline, Hank Williams classics and then mix it up with the more modern country and country rock.

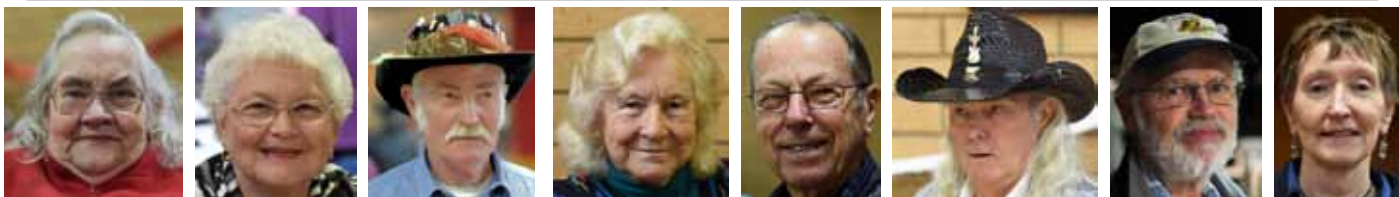
