Well another year has come and gone, a Happy New Year to all.

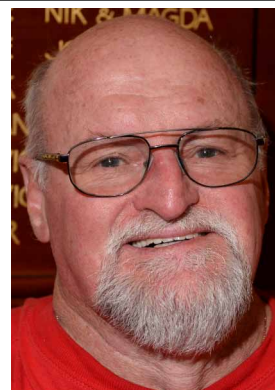

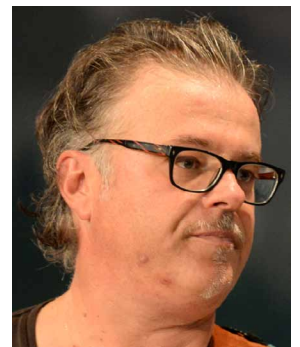

Thanks to Pam Fisk and Raelz for proof reading Country Call.

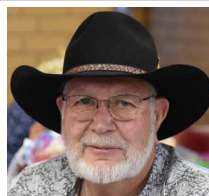
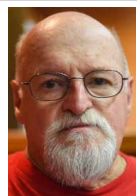
