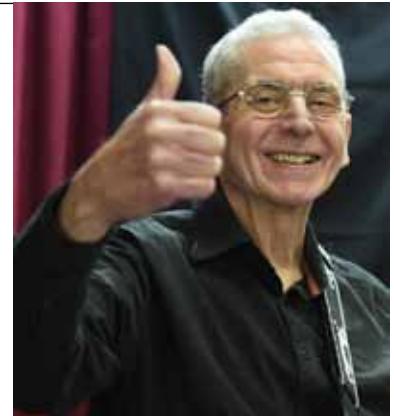
Early August Angela won the 2015 Brand New Star competition hosted by Today's Country 94 One radio station on the Central Coast NSW.
