It's time for another update and report from the President's desk to all our members and their friends who may read our 'Country Call'.

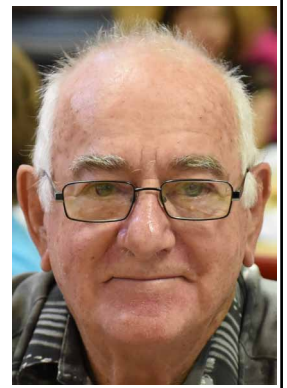

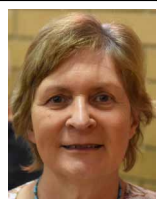
