Ross was well known for his fund raising for 'Angel Flight Foundation'. Helen was a very early member, perhaps an original member, who composed (with the help of Anne Wills) and recorded a song called "500 families" in remembrance of families who lost children with 'cot death' as Helen herself did. 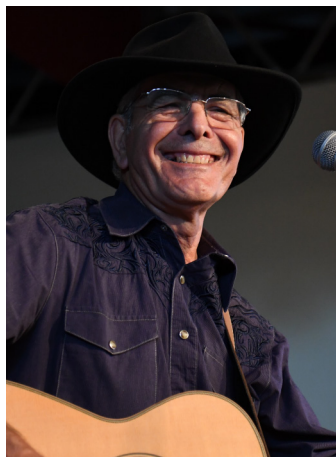

## June Show :- Sandra Humphries and Band

## July Show :- Bernie & the Bandits with guest artist Chooka Williams

Bernie and his band have been to the Club many times through the years.

From his site are these words.

'Bernie and the Bandits have been playing their own cabaret style of Country Music now for two decades. Bernie "the Bandit" Scott was born and bred in Yankalilla where he began drumming at the age of nine with his father in an old time dance band, moving on to rock bands in the 60's and 70's. He can play almost anything he picks up, including clarinet and saxophone.

David Cross joined Bernie and the Bandit's as keyboard player in 2002. He also sings and harmonises and like Bernie, David had his musical start in pop bands, crossing over to Country Music in the 80's.

Bobby Craig replaced Bert Elliott as the band drummer. Originally from Ireland, Bobby has been in Pop/Rock bands throughout his career. Bobby adds further to the versatility of the band with his vocals and harmonies.

Kevin Bergen - multitalented musician from Gawler, plays pedal steel, when a 5-piece band is required.

Ian Woods - on bass

Each of these talented members has earned themselves respect to go with their countless awards in the music industry over the years. Bernie and the Bandits are able to

mix and match a repertoire to suit audiences, with a little pop, 50's/60's rock'n'roll, country rock, military two steps mixed in with standards and classic country music.

They are a fun band with plenty of good sing-a-long country music!

In 2010 Chooka was inducted into the SA Country Music Hall of Fame at Barmera.

Chooka has a natural vibrato quality voice of strong country and has become very in demand around the Adelaide Country Music Circuit and beyond. A regular at the 'Alcheringa Shindig', Mildura & Barmera Country Music Festivals, Chooka has become a regular face. His willingness to always lend a hand at fundraisers right across the State has seen him become a favourite and respected performer not only with audiences but also with his many associates in the Country Music Arena.

Born in Ouyen on 10th August 1946, the 4th of five children in a musical family (his mother played piano), young Brian started to learn guitar, voice and presentation at an early age with Mary Cummins (song writer and singer and established country performer)

His first performance in 1964 was for the Ouyen District Hospital Fund Raising Concert, playing rhythm guitar and was lead singer with Owltones.

During the 70's and 80's he continued with "Martin, Barton & Fargo" band from the 80's.

His list of CDs range from his first - 'Sunset Country', recorded with Star Productions in 1997. Then followed in 1999, - 'Mallee Country'. 'Still Steady' his current CD is full of true country, which has been receiving very good airplay.

Chooka has many credits to his name over his career including participating in the Olympic Torch song contest with local children (who wrote the lyrics) and Chooka co-wrote the music of the winning song and performed with the children in Mildura while the cauldron was lit.

He is a very keen die hard Collingwood fan, do ask him how they are going, especially when Collingwood is losing!

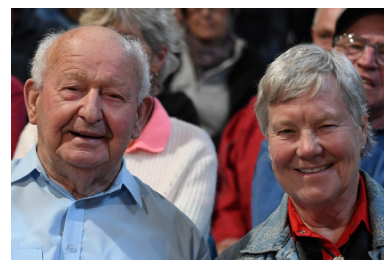
